**The Vice-Chancellor Prof. Som Nath Sachdeva chaired the meeting of the University Court as authorized by the Hon'ble Governor-Chancellor conveyed through the office of Secretary to Governor, Haryana Raj Bhavan, Chandigarh vide letter No. HRB-UA-2025/1533 dated 25<sup>th</sup> February, 2025. The Vice-Chancellor thanked Hon'ble Governor-Chancellor for authorizing him to act as Chairperson of the meeting of the University Court. He welcomed all members of the University Court present online and offline. Thereafter, Prof. Loveleen Mohan, Registrar-cum-Member-Secretary presented the agenda of the meeting sequentially.**

**THE MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE COURT ARE AS UNDER:**

1. To confirm the minutes of the 12<sup>th</sup> meeting of the University Court held on 18<sup>th</sup> April, 2024 at 12:00 Noon circulated vide letter No. CRSU/Acad./Court-12/Minutes/2024/13070-13100 dated 22.04.2024.

**Resolved that the minutes of 12<sup>th</sup> meeting of the University Court be confirmed.**

2. To note the follow up action taken report of the 12<sup>th</sup> meeting of the University Court held on 18<sup>th</sup> April, 2024 at 12:00 Noon.

**Resolved that the action taken report of 12<sup>th</sup> meeting of the University Court be noted.**

3. To note the nomination of Smt. Anju Gupta, Deputy Director as nominee of Director General Higher Education, Haryana to attend the meeting of University Court as per provision of University Act under "Court and its constitution" informed vide Memo No. 18/255-2018 UNP (5) dated 11.02.2025 by the O/o Additional Chief Secretary to Govt. of Haryana, Higher Education Department, Chandigarh.

**Resolved that the Nomination of Smt. Anju Gupta, Deputy Director as nominee of Director General Higher Education, Haryana to attend the meeting of the University Court be noted.**

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4. To consider and approve the recommendations of Finance Committee in its 13<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 03<sup>rd</sup> March, 2025 and Executive Council in its 39<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 04 March, 2025 in respect of Budget Estimates of Financial Year 2025-26, Revised Budget Estimates of Financial Year 2024-25 and Balance Sheet of Financial Year 2023-24 audited by the Chartered Accountant.

**RESOLUTION OF THE FINANCE COMMITTEE:**

**Considered and recommended to the Executive Council for approval by reducing the expenditure from Rs. 13876.47 lakh to Rs. 12637.47 lakh. Thus reducing the deficit from Rs. 1525.27 lakh to Rs. 286.27 lakh, as suggested by the committee members.**

**Further, Dr. Yashpal Singh Berwal (Nominee of ACS Technical Education, Haryana) has suggested that the University should try to meet out the budget deficit from their own resources/income.**

**Furthermore, he has also suggested that the financial viability of programmes running under self financing scheme may be re-assessed for further continuation of such programmes.**

**RESOLUTION OF THE EXECUTIVE COUNCIL:**

**Resolved that the recommendations of the Finance Committee be considered and recommended to the University Court for consideration and approval.**

**Resolved that the recommendations of the Executive Council be considered and approved.**

5. Under any other item 3 (ii) of the Finance Committee in its meeting held on 14.03.2024, it was also intimated by the Member-Secretary that several time bound bills (i.e. Electricity, Telephone, Water, Municipal Tax) raised by Central/State Govt. and other Board/Corporations/Local Bodies under the control of Central/State Govt. are received 1 or 2 days before the last date of depositing the amount and official process takes 3 to 4 days for obtaining the Financial approval from the Competent Authority of the University. In the above situation, there is a possibility of penalty/fine due to non- payment on due date. Therefore, it was proposed that Finance Officer of the University may be authorized to accord Financial Sanction to the above mentioned bills, if no penalties/fines etc. are involved. However, if there is involvement of any penalty/fine etc. in the above mentioned bills, then same will be put up to the Competent Authority of the University for Financial Sanction as per University provisions.

**RESOLUTION OF THE FINANCE COMMITTEE:**

**Considered and recommended to the Executive Council for approval.**

**Further, the nominee of the Additional Chief Secretary to the Government of Haryana, Finance Department, suggested that after obtaining approval from the Executive Council, the matter may be intimated to the Finance Department, Haryana through the Administrative Department i.e., the Directorate of Higher Education, Haryana.**

Garg (Department of Management, G.J.U, Hisar) has suggested that investment policy of the University may be re-framed by preferring the Public Sector Banks, keeping in view the safety and security of the University funds.
